SECTION VII: GENERAL CONDITION

1. In accordance with the article 52, 1st paragraph of the Consumer Code: for signed contracts, contractual proposals of registration at distance, and for any contract negotiated outside the site of "Nuova Accademia" (NABA), it is recognized to the student the right to withdraw from the contract without the risk of incurring in any extra expenditure and without the payment of any penalty, within fourteen working days from the conclusion of the contract (upon receiving the contract/enrollment form).

The student willing to withdraw shall send a written notification by registered mail containing name and surname, the address of the student, date and place, student's signature; it will be considered termination date, the date when the registered mail will be received. The written notification shall be addressed to: Nuova Accademia Srl – Via C. Darwin 20, 20143 Milano (MI).

- 2. If a student withdraws from the contract lawfully, he/ she has the right to get a refund of all the payments made order to NABA, except for the application fee.
- 3. NABA will activate undergraduate, postgraduate or master program only if a minimum of 10 participants will enroll. If the minimum number of students will not be reached, the course will not take place. NABA will inform the student in the case a course will not be run at least 30 days prior the beginning of the course itself. In such event, NABA will refund the students in the shortest possible term. NABA is exempted to refund any extra cost incurred by the students (i.e. travel, food, accommodation...) for the enrollment and admission process; nor of any further damage of different nature.
- Cancel a course
- Change a course
- Change location of classes.

If a student withdraws up to 1 day before the beginning of the program, the student has the right to get a refund of the tuition fee and Academic Contribution Fee.

Refund is not available for the application fees, pre-enrollment fee including the Regional Tax.

Alternatively, students will have the opportunity to move the enrollment to an other course or intake informing NABA of his/her decision timely.

If NABA is responsible for course cancellation, NABA will refund the student twice what has been paid.

Students enrolled in the 1 year of the second intake may submit an internal change request from a NABA course to another NABA course of the same level within one month from the start of the course.

5. Enrollment to a course, together with the payment of the required enrollment fee, creates a binding agreement to follow the course and to pay the full fees.

Except what indicate by the articles 1-2-3, the student who, after having requested and obtained the registration and signed this contract, during the academic year: a) does not duly attend the lessons and/or does not take the exams; b) formally withdraws from the course by completing the appropriate form, whatever the cause of his behavior and/or decision (including, for example and not exhaustively, personal and/or family reasons; work and any other reason), is not entitled to refund of the amount paid and/or to suspend the payment of the amount still due by way of Tax, Academic Contribution and Attendance fees, remaining obliged to pay the due amount according to the established manners and deadlines, and will remain bound to fulfill the payment of the annual amount of the Tuition and Contribution to teaching.

Students enrolled in the 1st year of three-year and two-year courses, whose withdrawal is formalized no later than the 14 days after the course beginning, will be obliged to pay 70% of the Tuition fee and of the Academic Contribution.

- 6. Between NABA, the student and his/her guarantors it is agreed that: the payment of the enrollment fee for the following years will be considered necessary and sufficient to validate the registration itself; this payment will be considered as a confirmations of the student's and his guarantors' agreement to the General Contact Conditions, including those subject to specific approval pursuant to Articles. 1341 and 1342 c.c.; consequently, upon registration, any obligation assumed by each of the parties as a result of signing this application will be confirmed. Starting from the academic year following the enrollment application, the tuition will be adjusted annually based on the Istat index.
- 7. In the event that the student informs in writing his/her intention to



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8. suspend his studies for the academic year following the current and such information is received within the deadlines for re-enrollment, the student must pay a fixed fee of Euro 300,00 for each academic year of suspension (for a maximum of three academic years). The fee and the Academic Contribution already paid, in this case, will be considered valid by NABA for the enrollment in the academic year following suspension, only if the student resumes his/her studies. In the event that the student decides not to resume studies at the end of the suspension period, the tuition fee, re-enrollment fee and academic contribution, already paid, will be definitely acquired by NABA.

Applications for suspension of studies for the academic year following the current one, submitted after the re-enrollment deadlines, cannot be taken into consideration and will have no effect on the payments made and to be executed.

In the event that the student does not formalize within the reenrollemnt deadlines, neither the withdrawal fromf the studies, nor the suspension of the studies, nor the reregistration, he/she will have the possibility, within the period of maximum 5 years, to rejoin his student career by paying a fixed fee of \in 2,000.00. The procedure provides that, upon request by the student to rejoin his/her academic career, NABA will proceed to carry out an academic assessment and a verification of any educational debits, following which the student's year of attendance will be defined. It is specified that the suspension of studies cannot be retroactive.

- 9. NABA reserves the right to use its discretion to determine number of courses and type of courses yearly set up for each program. NABA guarantees to enrolled students the minimum courses required to obtain the diploma within the prescribed time as defined by MIUR (Ministry of Education, University and Research) or any other current prographice.
- 10. Subjects may change for academic purposes or for Ministerial reasons related to the AFAM system (AFAM is the system of "Alta Formazione Artistica e Musicale", including all public and private Fine Arts and Music Academies recognized by the Ministry of Education itself).

The group of lessons assigned may change in the academic years following the first one for reasons related to didactic planning and to the choices made by the student during the completion of the study plan in relation to the major of specialization and the optional courses chosen.

- 11. Classes will take place weekly, according to the academic timetable defined annually.
- 12. 11. All students, upon enrollment, must possess the requisite of knowledge of the language in which the course is delivered (Italian or English). In any case, NABA reserves the right to request additional documentation at any time or to verify the certificate presented for those who deliver a certificate of linguistic suitability (among those recognized by NABA). If the student is unable to present one of the required certificates, NABA will test the student's language skills and assign him/her a level accordingly.

With the reference to Bachelors of Arts and Masters of Arts, if the obtained level is below the required one (for Masters, however, it must not be less than B1), students will have to attend the language remedial courses — organized by NABA in order to reach the required level (CEFR B1+) and only after the achievement of the above mentioned level the student will be able to sit the exams.

For further information, please refer to the Director's Decree number 29 of 21/12/2017 (published in the student reserved area of NABA website called MyNABA. Username and password will be provided at enrollment time).

Students who will not reach the required English/Italian level – which is an entry requirement will be enrolled in the Diploma program (auditor). This fact does not represent just cause of unilateral withdrawal and the refusal of the student to accept the enrollment into the Diploma program will have consequences and effects in accordance with Articles 5, 16 and 17.

The students who do not submit a valid language certificate (as per the language requirements reported in the application form) will be required to sit the Language Test that will be scheduled by NABA. The student who has not presented a valid language certificate attesting a suitable level and has not taken the test scheduled by NABA will not be able to participate in the educational activities and will be removed from the lesson records.

Furthermore, all students enrolled in the three-year BA courses in Italian are also required to take the NABA English language test in order to determine the level of proficiency in the language.

The test results are expressed according to the grading system defined by the European Framework of Reference for languages (CEFR). This test gives the right to the acquisition of credits if exceeded, otherwise it involves the attribution of a formative debt that must be remedied for the attainment of the degree (level B1 +).

- 13. NABA guarantees to students access to educational areas for all the duration of classes as per the academic year timetable, and the number of hours, which are necessary to complete the program. Further access to campus spaces is subject to didactic needs and logistic availability.
- 14. NABA is not responsible for any deficiency or delay in the performance, in whole or in part arising from or attributable to failure to comply with any obligation, caused by or attributable to acts and failure to comply with obligations by third parties, events, omissions and/or accidents beyond possible and reasonable control, such as, but not limited to, strikes or other disputes involving our staff or other third-party personnel, natural disasters, wars, revolts, civil uprisings, voluntary damages, in accordance with any law or governmental regulations, rules or directives, accidental breakdowns of plant or machinery, fires, floods, storms, pandemics, epidemics or other spreads of diseases and/or infections in the failed public supply of energy and services, telecommunications and/or Information Technology.
- 15. Each and every Intellectual Property Rights that will result from the creative and/or inventive activity inherent to the activities, studies, experimentation, planning carried out by individual student or groups of students, within an educational project, under the guidance of NABA 's teachers and/or directors, and any and all materials created, designed and carried out by students during the academic activity (including, by way of example but not limited to: notes, presentations, texts, projects or other) will be exclusive property and ownership of NABA and is intended by the student as of now transferred definitively and free of charge to the same, which will have every right of exploitation, economic use and disposal of it for any reason (including, by way of example but not limited to, advertising purposes, promotional, internal strategy, information or research, educational or experimental).

Consequently, NABA will hold each right to register the Intellectual Property Rights and copyrights in national, European and international registers, without prejudice to the student right to be recognized as author.

- 16. Enrollment fee, Academic Contribution Fee and tuition fee do not include photocopies, lecture notes, colour printings, materials to be used for all project workshops, as well as computer rendering of the final thesis, participation to exhibits or contests.
- 17. Late payments of the Enrollment fee, Academic Contribution fee and tuition fee, or any instalment, will imply a fine of €50 up to 30 days delays and €100 for further delay. However students are not allowed to enter classes until the time they pay the overdue amount. In case of late payment, the student's attendance will not be registered and this absence will not be justified.
- 18. NABA reserves the right to require to non-paying students the immediate payment of the outstanding amount, suspending or excluding them from the program and from exams as well as to start the necessary legal action for retrieving the total amount including all expenses: interests, fines, legal billings and everything else as per art 16.
- 19. Students are required to comply with the regulations regarding the norms of behavior which have to be respected inside the Academy (the Code of conduct), the norms of use of the students email account, the Academy computers and the personal badge available in the personal area of the NABA website in the section Didactic > Regulations.

Breaches of the norms may lead to the application of disciplinary actions corresponding with the seriousness and recurrence of the facts, and which may include also the temporary or permanent suspension from the Academy.

- 20. NABA reserves the right to seek compensation for any damages incurred by the student to the premises and equipment. The student is required to use them correctly and to respect the cleanliness of the premises and areas of common use.
- 21. It is forbidden to bring dogs and others animals in NABA campus.



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- 22. NABA is not responsible under any condition for any object lost or property left unattended in the Academy structures.
- 23. First-year Students residing for at least 3 years in a European Union country and who do not present the documentation related to the family income for the allocation of the income bracket within the start of the program, will be assigned automatically to the highest family income bracket

The income bracket determined for the year of enrollment must be reconfirmed for subsequent years by presenting suitable documentation by November 30th. The income bracket will remain unchanged until the entire documentation requested is delivered within the set terms

- 24. Students enrolled in the 3rd year of one of the undergraduate courses or in the 2nd year of one of the postgraduate courss are required to pay NABA a contribution of 540 euros for the Final Thesis Exam and to the Italian Agenzia delle Entrate a tax of € 90,84 in order to receive the Degree on parchment paper (amount defined except for the adjustment that may be indicated in the academic diploma regulation of the Academic Year of Graduation) within the scheduled payment deadlines. Students enrolled in a Master's course are required to pay NABA only the contribution of € 540 for the Final Thesis Exam.
- 25. The enrollment of the student in possession of a foreign secondary school diploma is accepted upon the following conditions:
- a. The awarded Diploma allows the access to the Academic course chosen by the student; this requirement is confirmed by the declaration of value of the foreign diploma and the official Italian translation of the original study title.
- b. the foreign diploma has been awarded after the minimum number of years of education required by ministerial dispositions for enrolling to academic studies.
- A Board of Examiners designed by the Director of Education will evaluate the validity of the Declaration of Value of the foreign secondary

- school Diploma. In case the Declaration of Value not considered suitable by the Board, the student will be enrolled to the Diploma program Course (auditor) of the same course, without obtaining the academic formative credits and the 1st level Academic Bachelor degree (ref. Academy Didactic Regulations art. 21/2). In case the foreign diploma does not meet the requirements of the Italian Ministry of Education, this fact does not represent just cause of unilateral withdrawal and the refusal of the student to is accept the enrollment into the Diploma program (auditor) will have consequences and effects in accordance with Articles 5, 16 and/or 17.
- 26. The enrollment in a Degree program is under the conditions that students have all the required papers to enter the country and live in Italy as per the Italian law in force during the Academic year in which the mentioned students want to study at NABA.NABA is not responsible for the release of the permit to study in Italy and for the VISA, which will have to be obtained by the students themselves and at their expenses from the competent authorities.
- 27. This is also recognized in the event that the student requests and obtains the transfer of an internal course during the enrollment period. 1) Why you are receiving this communication

Nuova Accademia S.r.l., as Data Controller, wishes to inform you about the type of data we collect and the methods we use to do this, in order to guarantee respect for your fundamental rights and freedoms, with particular reference to the confidentiality and security with which the data are processed.

2) What personal data we collect

Nuova Accademia S.r.I. collects and stores your personal data at the time of enrolment/registration:

- identifying data such as given name, surname, residential address, email address, studies completed, citizenship, gender, place and date of birth, telephone number, copy of identity card/passport;
- your banking data and/or those belonging to the person making the payment;
- possible person to be contacted for administrative aspects, including payments;
- information about your/your family income, assets;
- possible rental lease for non-resident students;
- any medical certifications proving disability;
- academic career / curriculum vitae;
- copy of identity card/passport of the person who acts as the student's legal guardian;

4) How long we retain your personal data

6) Who can access your personal data
